The grace of Christ attend you; the love of God surround you; the Holy Spirit keep you; this day and for ever. *Amen!*

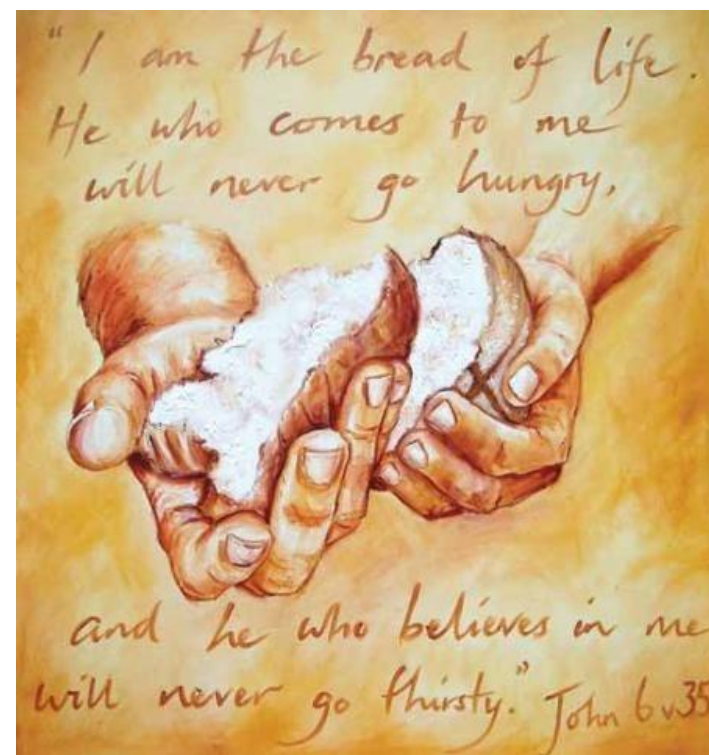
