RESPONSIVE READING

In You, O Lord, I have taken refuge; let me never be put to shame. Rescue me and deliver me in Your righteousness; turn Your ear to me and save me. Be my rock of refuge, to which I can always go; give the command to save me, for You are my rock and my fortress.

For You have been my hope, O Sovereign Lord, my confidence since my youth. From birth I have relied on You; you brought me forth from my mother's womb. I will ever praise You. I have become like a sign to many, but You are my strong refuge. My mouth is filled with Your praise, declaring Your splendour all day long.

Do not cast me away when I am old; do not forsake me when my strength is gone. Be not far from me, O God; come quickly to help me.
